Faculty List

Ensure that the requesting faculty member appears on the Faculty List below.

Traditional Undergraduate Course

Verify that the course meets these criteria and thus is a "traditional" course for Learning Through Dialogue and Discussion purposes:

- Is an undergraduate course
- Spans a full fall or spring semester
- Is not fully online or hybrid
- Is 3 or 4 credits
- Enrolls traditional students (for example, those who are pursuing their first bachelor's degree and are not participating in an accelerated program)

Attribute

Add the Learning Through Dialogue and Discussion attribute, Dialogue *and Discussion*, in CaneLink. All Learning Through Dialogue and Discussion courses, regardless of the specific methodology used, should have this attribute.
